Abstract in inglese

The workshop focuses on the juridification of Restorative Justice (RJ) in Italy, recently introduced in Law 134/2021 and Legislative Decree 150/2022, seeing that the RJ can be observed with the keys of sociology of law both as a space of de- and re-institutionalization of conflict, both as a legal field where to analyze the dynamics and relationships between political and administrative issues. As the new legislation requires to implement in Italy a new organic discipline of Restorative Justice (referred to EU Directive 2012/29/EU and to the principles established in the Recommendation of the Council of Europe CM /Rec (2018)8 (L. 134/2021, art.1, c.18-20)), the workshop will offer an opportunity for training and debate. It will be structured in two parts: the first part focused on a dialogue between two witnesses, who will guide the group of participants/listeners to identify not only the characteristics of RJ, its models and tools, and the most important stages of the development of the RJ practices in our country, but also the risk of instrumental uses, in the context of criminal policies;

the second part will be dedicated to the discussion on the basis of a film suggestion and some questions that will be proposed to the group by the two witnesses.
